A New Chapter: Graduation and Beyond

Recently, I have been spending a lot of time in the letters of Peter and in fact have been preaching through 1 Peter in my radio sermons for our local Echoes of Mercy radio program and have now decided to preach through the letters of Peter for our congregation. Peter being a disciple of Jesus while he was here on this earth had a tremendous witness to the majesty of Christ and His gospel as he himself says in 2 Peter 1:16-18. His letters are simply a message to us who have received the revelation of Jesus Christ, to live out our existence here in this world as the imitators of Jesus in the power of His resurrection, His resurrection which has become our own resurrection. As I thought of the message that Peter was bringing to the people of his day, I was struck by the power of the word of God and how it not only addresses its original audience, but still addresses us powerfully today. Indeed it is an eternal message that will have its effect in the hearts and minds of people until the day that Christ is seen by sight and we no longer walk by faith. I wonder if Peter the fisherman who becomes "a fisher of men" had any realization of the impact that his letters would have. That, in fact, what he wrote would become not just Peter's words but the word of God. It is this word of God and its message that speaks mightily yet today. It is a message for young and old alike.

With that thought in mind I would like to address this article to our young adults who are graduating from high school and considering what their next chapter in life will bring them. Consider always what the word of God says and how it addresses you who are believers living in the year of our Lord, 2017. Peter writes in 1 Peter 1:13-16 "Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy." Peter is telling us and you to have the understanding of your salvation through the finished work of Christ clear in your minds. He uses the imagery of wrapping a belt around your mind just like the ancients who wore long robes would do when they needed to move quickly, they would tuck their long robes into their belt so they wouldn't impede their movements. So you as

well are to have this understanding clear in your minds as you embark on this new chapter in your life. Have your hope completely on the grace of God that is being brought to you by the revelation of Jesus Christ. You are holy so walk as the obedient children of God not being shaped by the things of this world that are contrary to Christ, but rather walking as those who are set apart by Him. You have been purchased with a great price, not with this world's currency, but by the precious blood of Christ. It is by the revelation of Christ that you are able to be believers in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave him splendor, so that your faith and hope are in God. It is the word of God that has accomplished all of this as it is a living and eternal word. Young people do not neglect the word of God or its teachings. Peter writes later 1 Peter 2:11-12 "Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation." Although we are temporary residents in this world we are the eternal residents of Heaven. Peter encourages us and you, as citizens of heaven, to abstain from the passions of the flesh which war against your soul. Live your lives with honor among the unconverted so when they speak badly about you, they will by your noble behavior praise God on the day of their conversion. It is your witness to Jesus Christ that will have an impact on your colleagues and friends. Live as people who are free, but don't use your freedom to cover up evil. Respect everyone you encounter especially those in authority over you. Go to church and enjoy the fellowship of believers. Live in reverence of your God who has given you life and salvation. Finally and most importantly, Remain close to the Good Shepherd and Overseer of your lives, Jesus the Christ. He will never leave you or forsake you and will be with you always until the final chapter is reached and you come to not "the end" but rather you step into eternity. God bless you as turn the page of the current chapter of your life and begin the next.
