Come and See

"Come and see" is what Jesus says to the followers of John the baptizer when John points to Him and says "Behold the Lamb of God." John 1:35-39 " Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples; And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God! And the two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus. Then Jesus turned, and saw them following, and saith unto them, What seek ye? They said unto him, Rabbi, (which is to say, being interpreted, Master,) where dwellest thou? He saith unto them, Come and see. They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day: for it was about the tenth hour."

These followers of John the Baptist wanted to know where Jesus lived. He says to them come and see because this is the nature of the gospel. The Word became flesh and dwelt among men. He invites them to come and see where He lives because He lives here in this world making the Father know. Come and see the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Come and see the miracle worker who changes water into wine and feeds 5,000 men plus women and children with five barley loaves and two small fishes. Come and see the Man who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Come and see the Man who gives sight to a blind man and raises Lazarus from the dead. Come and see a Man who says I have overcome this world be at peace. Come and see a Man who prays for His followers so that they might be filled with joy and set apart in the truth. Come and see a Man who is the Lamb of God. Come and see Immanuel: God with us.

Philip invites Nathaniel to "Come and see" when he heeded the call of Jesus to follow Him. John 1:43-46 "The day following Jesus would go forth into Galilee, and findeth Philip, and saith unto him, Follow me. Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph. And Nathanael said unto him, Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see."

"Come and see" is an invitation that comes from the

Gospel of John, an invitation to see the Son of God, the King of Israel. This Nathaniel recognized upon meeting Jesus. John 1:47-49 "Jesus saw Nathanael coming to him, and saith of him, Behold an Israelite indeed, in whom is no guile! Nathanael saith unto him, Whence knowest thou me? Jesus answered and said unto him, Before that Philip called thee, when thou wast under the fig tree, I saw thee. Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, thou art the Son of God; thou art the King of Israel."

In this gospel we are called to see in the reading and hearing of the text: Jesus the Christ, the Son of God. We are called to believe that we might have life through His name. Just like Nathaniel, who was skeptical at best upon the announcement of Philip that they had found the Messiah, we too are called to come and see. We do this through the Word of God. The Bible, the Holy Scriptures give to us the revelation of God through Jesus Christ. By these words our eyes are opened and we are able to see.

There is another group of people in John's gospel who wanted to see. John 12:20-21 "And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast: The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus." And upon hearing this Jesus answers in this way. John 12:23-33 "And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour. Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour. Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again. The people therefore, that stood by, and heard it, said that it thundered: others said, An angel spake to him. Jesus answered and said,

This voice came not because of me, but for your sakes. Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out. And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me. This he said, signifying what death he should die."

This is ultimately what we are called to come and see. Come see the Man hanging on a cross, hanging there for you and me. Come and see the Man who dies so that we might live. Come and see the Man who in His death defeats death as well as sin and the prince of this world. This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Come and see Him in His death and resurrection. Come and see the God-man who brings you eternal life and a new identity, for as many as received Him to them He gave power or the right to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name. Come and see and believe.
